### **RULES & REGULATIONS      REMEMBER TO ENTER FROM MULBERRY STREET GATE ONLY!**

Entry forms will be returned if ALL THE FOLLOWING ITEMS are not complied with. SIGNED BY CONTESTANT & WAIVER SIGNED BY PARENT OR GUARDIAN, WITH PARENTS SIGNATURE NOTARIZED BY NOTARY PUBLIC OR COPY OF DRIVER'S LICENSE. Cashier's Check or Money Order Only! SECRETARY WILL DRAW FAMILY MEMBERS UP ON THE SAME DAY UNLESS OTHERWISE REQUESTED.

1. Entries must be postmarked no later than August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2019.
2. Entry fees in the correct amount **MUST** accompany entry forms (no cash or personal checks). Stock and office fees **WILL NOT BE REFUNDED**. Absolutely **NO REFUNDS** for any reason after August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2019. Draw will be posted on website by September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
3. Contestants must be no older than (19) years as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019, to compete in rodeo events. Proof of birth must accompany entry.
4. Admission fee at the gate is \$5.00; each contestants name will be on a list at the gate. Contestant numbers must be picked up at the Rodeo office at check-in,; Or prior to the rodeo or day of your performance.
5. **GROUND RULES MEETING 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO ALL PERFORMANCES, PLEASE ATTEND BEFORE COMPETING. PARENTS OF MINORS PLEASE ATTEND AS WELL. IF YOU DID NOT ATTEND THE MEETING, NO EXCUSE FOR NOT KNOWING THE RULES COVERED AT THE MEETING OR ON THIS SHEET.**
6. **NO RE-RIDES IN PEE WEE EVENTS.**
7. **AFTER INITIAL ENTRY TO THE EVENT YOU MUST HAVE YOUR BACK NUMBER WITH YOU OR YOU WILL HAVE TO PAY.**
8. During competition back numbers **MUST** be worn or contestant will be **DISQUALIFIED**.
9. **DRESS CODE:** contestants must wear western attire in arena **AND** track while on horseback. Failing to comply will result in DQ. Western Attire consists of cowboy hat or helmet, buttoned up long sleeve shirt, western pants and boots. This includes anyone assisting inside arena or track.
10. Chute Dogging: Will be out of Bucking Chute.
11. Awards as follows: Buckles for first in all events. **ALL AROUND BITS AND RESERVE ALL AROUND HEADSTALLS.** Awards based on points won. Points based on a 10,8,7,6 ... (yes this is correct).
12. Sunday after the rodeo we will be presenting event buckles and All-Around awards to the contestants at our awards dinner following the rodeo.
13. **GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE:** Contestants **ONLY** must address all questions or problems to the Arena or Track Directors. Parent or other interested Person, who gets involved with the event director, judges, or other rodeo official, runs the risk of having the person whom they are trying to assist get **DISQUALIFIED**.
14. All-Around tie breaker: 1. Most money won. 2. Entered in two or more events but winning the most money in a single event. **NOTE:** Ground split money goes to Scholarship Fund, will not be posted toward All-Around.
15. 40% will be deducted from all entry fees for office and stock fees-60% Payout.
16. Team Ropers: Confirm partner **BEFORE** entering. No refunds if partner fails to enter. We will **NOT** find you a partner or call you if your partner does not enter. If your name is not listed on the draw in team roping your partner did not enter.
17. Barrel Racers: One pivot in arena allowed before advancing toward first barrel. Raking will be done per discretion of the Arena Director.
18. You will be disqualified for sharing horses in the same age group in Pole bending, Single Stake or Barrel only.
19. All Mutton Busting and Dummy Roping contestants must have entries postmarked no later than August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2019. No sign-ups on either day of the rodeo.
20. All contestants shall comply with the rules. Any unsportsmanlike conduct will result in disqualification. Judges will make the final determination.
21. No exhibition rides allowed due to insurance.
22. **Sr. Boys Bulls, Sr. Boys Saddle Bronc & Sr. Boys Bareback-SUNDAY ONLY**
