## QUALIFICATIONS

- Senior Queen Contestants must not be less than 12 years of age, or more than 19 years of age, as of January 1<sup>st</sup> t, 2026. Junior Queen Contestants must not be less than 8 years of age, or no more than 11 years of age, as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. (Birth Certificates may be required upon request.)
- 2. Contestants must never have been married, engaged, pregnant or had children.
- 3. Contestants must reside and be residents of Tehama, Butte, Glenn, Shasta, Trinity, Plumas, Lassen or Modoc Counties of California. Contestants who reside outside of those counties who wish to compete, must be approved by the Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Committee. Contestants must understand there are several MANDATORY FUNCTIONS that must be attended throughout her reign, and if not fulfilled, she will need to forfeit her title.
- 4. Contestants must have sold or raised the minimum of \$1000 worth of Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Scholarship Dinner tickets and or Sponsorships/Silent Auction Donations obtained prior to riding in horsemanship on the contest day. Points are offered for sponsorships obtained.
- 5. Contestants must enter at least one event at the Cattle Days Rodeo prior to competing in the contest.
- 6. Contestant must have a 70% score or higher in each area on their contest to be able to represent the association. The association has the right to roll a Jr. Queen Contestant to the Sr. Queen if no Sr. Queen Contestant fulfills this requirement.

(Print Your Name), the undersigned Miss Red Bluff Junior l, Round-Up Rodeo contestant agree to abide by the following statements, and understand that violation of any may result in my immediate disqualification from the contest.

- 1. I will attend ALL required activities and events as scheduled and directed by my Directors.
- 2. I will maintain a desirable attitude professional conduct and be honest.
- 3. I will meet all eligibility requirements.
- 4. I will not appear, or be under the influence of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs at any time while representing the Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo.
- 5. I will not attempt to influence or affect the outcome of the contest at the expense of a fellow contestant, a contestant's property or horse or any other behavior or conduct deemed unacceptable by the Coordinator and/or Judges.
- 6. I agree for pictures to be released to newspapers as well as other publications for publicity of the Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo.
- 7. I will abide by the rules, regulations and guidelines outlined in the packet given to me published by Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo Committee.
- 8. I agree and will abide by the \$1000 requirement.

#### Should I be selected as the 2026 Miss Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo Queen or Princess, I also agree to the following:

- 1. As Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo's official ambassador, I shall represent Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo in a positive, professional and honorable manner.
- 2. I will adhere to and demonstrate high moral, ethical and professional character.
- 3. I will represent excellent sportsmanship and humane treatment of animals in all competitive and recreational activities.
- 4. I will act, dress and speak properly at any time while in public, appearing in full western attire, hair curled with hat, crown, buckle and banner when appropriate.
- 5. I will be available to all reasonable requests and opportunities to appear in public on behalf of Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo.
- 6. I will participate in various fundraising events for the Red Bluff Junior Round-Up.
- 7. I will attend ALL parades and functions such as but not limited to the Red Bluff Christmas Parade, Red Bluff Round-Up Rodeo Parade, Red Bluff Round-Up Rodeo grand entries, Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Cattle Days, Red Bluff Bull and Gelding Sale, Tehama District Fair & Miss Tehama County Pageant, Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Scholarship Dinner & Auction, Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Horsemanship, Queen Crowning and Red Bluff Junior Round-Up.
- 8. I will allow my name and likeness to be used at no obligation in the promotion of the Red Bluff Junior Round-Up.
- 9. I will routinely consult with the Coordinator to schedule approved appearances, and not appear unless previously approved by the Coordinator.
- 10. I will present through the 2026-2027 contest and coronation for Miss Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo and will attend at the 2026 & 2027 opening performances.

- I understand that the crowns, chaps, and buckles are property of Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo and should a crown be lost or damaged while under my control, I will be held responsible for replacing it.
- 12. I will compete in at least one event in both Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo and Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Cattle Days.
- 13. I \_\_\_\_\_\_\_(print name) understand and accept that in the event that I fail to comply in part of whole with any of the above requirements, I will promptly be relieved of my title and its inherent duties and responsibilities and benefits, and return all gifts and prizes. The first runner-up will then assume the position, including its duties and responsibilities for the remainder of the reign, provided that she meets the eligibility requirements. Should the first runner-up fail to meet those qualifications or be unwilling to assume those duties, the second runner-up will be the queen, also contingent upon meeting eligibility standards.
- 14. All of the information contained within this application is true and correct. I understand, accept and am willing to carry out the duties and responsibilities as outlined in this application, as Miss Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Rodeo or a runner-up.
- 15. The Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Queen Committee has the authority to make decisions and waive eligibility rules and/or regulation requirements with the approval of the Red Bluff Junior Round-Up Association. Applications and rules are subject to change,
- 16. When assuming a Red Bluff Jr. Round-Up Queen or Princess title, you are not permitted to run for any other title in the duration of your current title.
